Ruby Kate spends much of her time at the nursing home where her mom works, and it was there she noticed a resident who was sad because she couldn't afford the cost of having her dog brought to her for visits as much as she'd like. Ruby Kate thought other residents might also have some wishes that she might be able to help fulfill. She took a notebook with her the next time and began asking the residents what three things in the world they wished they had. Ruby Kate was surprised by the simplicity of their wishes: small things like McDonald's fries and a more comfortable pillow. She realized it wouldn't take much to make their wishes come true if she could get others to help her. With her mom's help, she started a GoFundMe page to raise money to meet the wishes of the residents. To date, Ruby Kate has raised almost \$300,000 to help residents at multiple nursing homes, and her official non-profit "Three Wishes for Ruby's Residents" has even opened a community center to connect older and younger generations!
