CREATIVITY GAME:

Grab a sheet of paper and draw a circle in the middle of it. During the meal, pass the piece of paper around the table and take turns adding to the drawing. The first person should start with the circle and turn it into something, like a ladybug or a wheel or an eyeball. Then the next person should add to the picture, such as drawing grass, a wagon or a face. Keep passing until you've filled up the page together with a creative scene.

How do you think the artwork you created together is different from what you would create on your own? Was it easy or hard to work together? How did you have to adjust and compromise as you worked? Did that adjusting and compromising require more creativity? Why or why not? What is a way your family can work together in your everyday life to make the world better?
